

COLLABORATION AGREEMENT

between

University of Trnava, Faculty of Law

The goal of this agreement is to develop educational, scientific and cultural collaboration between the above mentioned partners through teacher and student exchanges, teaching scholarship and research; exchange of publications; mutual participation at professional conferences and workshops.

The contracting faculties agreed the following forms of collaboration:

Article 1

Both faculties plan short-term visits of professionals and scientist. The exchange visit is focused on lecturing. Lecture topics are expected to be agreed upon in advance of the visit.

Article 2

Both faculties will encourage and support student exchanges. This covers exchanges relations in academic studies as well as cultural and other fields.

Article 3

Both partners will support mutual participation at professional conferences, symposiums, workshops organized by the other partner.

Article 4

Reciprocal exchange of experiences and scientific knowledge in form of exchange of lecturers, researchers, students and staff.

Article 5

- (1) Both faculties agreed that particular conditions and the extend of cooperation (e.g. financial business, deadlines and other terms referred to the mobilities or to common projects) will by settled between partners at least one month in advance.
- (2) In accordance with this agreement no tuition fees will be claimed by hosting faculty.
- (3) The incoming student attends the courses, performs task an takes exams according to learning agreement between sending and hosting faculty. Upon accomplishing the stay, the hosting faculty will provide the student with official documents specifying the activities during the stay, attended courses and the level of performance of task and taken exams.

Article 6

The insurance expenses during the stay will be covered by the participants in the exchange program.

Article 7

Travel expenses for the academic and research staff will be carried by the sending faculty, living expenses (accomodation and per diem) by the hosting university.

Article 8

Duration of this agreement is indefinite, as long as one of the contracting faculties denounce the agreement in written form, providing, that all mutual responsibilities are aligned.

Article 9

This agreement is written in four originals in English language.
